Baptism during 9am Sunday Mass:

Today we welcome Andreas Faamoe (Baby of David and Sabrina) in the Sacrament of Baptism to be celebrated during the 9:00 am Mass today. The liturgy begins with the naming of the child and the sign of the cross. Following the Liturgy of the Word, the homily and the 1st Collection, we move to the next part of the rite – Intercessions, Litany of Saints, anointing with the Oil of Catechumens. This is followed by the Blessing of Water (with our response: Glory and praise to you, O God.). With the baptismal water blessed the parents and godparents renounce sin and profess the Christian faith (we all join in this by saying I do.) After this is the pouring of water, the anointing with Chrism, clothing with a white garment, presentation of the baptismal candle and the Ephpehetha rite. When all this is completed Mass continues with the 2nd collection and preparation of gifts.
