Liturgy Point:

From "Becoming Eucharistic People" by Timothy P. O'Malley:

The Mass is about what Christ has accomplished through his Death, Resurrection, and Ascension into heaven. Christ died for the salvation of the world. Death is the great problem that no human being can solve. Only God can transform the meaninglessness of death through an act of love that forever changes what it means to be human. Because Jesus Christ is the God-man, resurrected from the dead, death has no power to slay, the Divine love revealed on the Cross, is the exclusive source of credibility. At Mass, it is this entire Paschal Mystery – Christ's life, death, Resurrection and Ascension- that is remembered and celebrated. The Church comes forth from this Eucharistic mystery – the self-giving love of Christ that gathers all men and women into this common act of worship. Liturgy is the work of God upon the people, bringing us into a communion of love that we ourselves could never create. Liturgy is gift.
