Readings for next weekend — Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time

First reading: Jeremiah 38:4-6, 8-10; Second reading: Hebrews 12:1-4; Gospel: Luke 12:49-53

Falling in love!

Vigilance is not just an Advent theme! Today's gospel reminds us we must be vigilant and ready for the unexpected coming of Christ.

The gospel can raise some level of fear as we hear about the servant who is punished for his lack of preparedness upon the return of the master. But Jesus clearly states that we ought not be afraid, for the Father "is pleased to give (us) the kingdom." It's a reality he also emphasises with his disciples at the Last Supper (John 14).

Our preparedness of the inevitable coming of the kingdom is a posture of readiness – and therefore of faith – as we acknowledge the desire of the Father to take us to himself. Just like the Israelites celebrating the Passover in Egypt, we are asked to be in a state of departure on the basis of our faith in God who leads us out of the slavery (of sin) to the freedom of the kingdom (heaven). This faith is the realisation of what is Hoped for and evidence of things unseen.

On this side of heaven, our preparedness consists of *falling in love*, because our ultimate end is complete and perfect communion with love itself (God).


