## **Evangelisation**

In response to the 2012 Bishops' synod, Pope Francis set out a plan for change. In "Joy of the Gospel", he said that our primary job is to evangelise. All the popes since Pope Paul VI in the 1970s have been saying this. But so far, our focus has remained "upmarket", ministering to those of us who have already been evangelised.

Pope Francis insists that we focus on evangelisation not just because that teaching is in line With a long tradition of the Church, dating back to Jesus' last words to his disciples (Matthew 28:18-20). Pope Francis sees a real danger in the world: The great danger in today's world, pervaded as it is by consumerism, is the desolation and anguish born of a complacent yet covetous heart, the feverish pursuit of frivolous pleasures, and a blunted conscience. (Joy of the Gospel #2)

To evangelise is to literally announce good news. Sometimes however, we can get so caught up in all the details of the Good News that we turn it into boring news. Or even worse, we turn it into daunting news, a list of doctrines and precepts that must be assented to before one can be saved. Pope Francis is telling us we have to focus on the essentials of the faith. [to be continued]
