And of course, we are still waiting (ever so patiently) for construction to commence on our new meeting room and toilet block.

Our Thursday nights, currently reflecting on the Gospel of St. Matthew, will shortly transition into an Advent reflection program - lasting the four weeks of Advent and will provide a wonderful way to prepare for Christmas, and a necessary antidote to all the retail hoopla and bother leading up to the celebration of the Incarnation. Friday January 2nd 2026 will be our Epiphany Carols evening, the selection of the baby to play the part of baby Jesus will be occurring soon.

We have much to be thankful for over this past year and much to look forward to in the year ahead.
