

RCIA – THE SCRUTINIES

At the 9:00 am Mass today (and for the next two Sundays) we will celebrate the Rite of Scrutiny with the elect (those preparing for baptism at the Easter Vigil) We will be using the Year "A" readings over these three Sundays. As the elect (Thomas and Alita) journey into the heart of Lent, they prepare ever more intensely for their sacramental initiation. On the third, fourth and fifth Sundays of Lent the whole community intercedes with and for the elect, that they may be set free from the power of evil and confirmed in the spirit of Christ. For it is Christ who is their living water, their light and their resurrection and life.

After the homily the elect and their godparents will be called forth, we will pray for them in a litany – our response is Kyrie leison. There will then be a prayer for the elect and the laying on of hands by the presider, godparents and catechists. After this we will sing 1 verse of the hymn "I heard the voice of Jesus." At the conclusion of the rite the elect will be sent out to reflect more deeply on today's liturgy of the word. Meanwhile we will continue with the creed and the prayers of the faithful.

I invite you to offer prayer and sacrifice for Thomas and Alita as they make this journey to the Easter Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist to be celebrated at the Easter Vigil (March 30th).
