Synod and Pastoral Plan

On Saturday April 5th 7:30 pm we will be holding our next "Table-talk" and the theme for this one will be "Mission". Mission is one of the five priorities backing up the Diocesan Pastoral Plan. The other themes are: Prayer, Formation, Listening, Dialogue and Discernment, and Community.

From "Behold I am always with you", Diocesan Pastoral Plan 2024-28: As our diocese moves towards becoming a more Synodal Church, 'mission' emphasises that the Church exists to evangelise, that is, to share the Good News. As such, the Church cannot be centred on itself. Its deeply missionary dimension, expressed through a commitment to the way of synodality, enables the Church to better witness to the Gospel, especially to those on the spiritual, social, economic, political, geographical peripheries of our world.

By prioritising 'mission', we aim to live out our call to be a sign of God's Love in the midst of the human family, responding to the needs of our time with faith and compassion, and serving as a leaven for the coming of God' kingdom.

Part of our Parish vision is that all of us would be able to live and share the Good news of Jesus. So, this upcoming table-talk is an opportunity to gather with fellow parishioners for a meal, listen to some stories about the being a **Mission Oriented Church**, and participating in conversation around this topic.
