

Readings for next weekend — Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time
First reading: Isaiah 58:7-10; Second reading: 1 Corinthians 2:1-5; Gospel: Matthew 5:13-16

Gaudete et Exultate:

In 2018, Pope Francis released an apostolic letter called *Gaudete et Exultate*, “On the call to holiness in today’s world”. Probably because it’s not very controversial, it has remained one of Francis’ lesser known document. This is rather sad because it is beautiful and important statement about what is at the heart of living as a follower of Jesus: what the Second Vatican Council called the universal call to holiness.

The letter is made up of five chapters, and one of the chapters (#3) is devoted entirely to a reflection on the gospel we are reading at Mass today: the Beatitudes. Just twelve verses of all the gospels, but Francis found them important enough to devote quite a large portion of his apostolic letter to considering them.

Francis introduces the chapter by writing: “Jesus explained with great simplicity what it means to be holy when he gave us the Beatitudes. The Beatitudes are like a Christian’s identity card. So, if anyone asks ‘What must one do to be a good Christian?’, the answer is clear. In the Beatitudes, we find a portrait of the Master, which we are called to reflect in our daily lives.”

Francis then proceeds to consider each beatitude, one by one reflecting on what each says about what it means to be holy – not for some long-dead believer in some inaccurately imagined past, but in the real world, in the midst of our real lives, today.

When should I complete my Safeguarding Training?

All Clergy, employees and volunteers in parish ministry are required by the NSW Children's Guardian Act 2019 to be **current and complete with Safeguarding Training**. Check with your Parish Office when you are due to update your Safeguarding Training.

- If you are new to ministry, you must complete the Introductory Modules 1-3 (Cycle 1).
- If you completed Cycle 1 modules two years ago, you must complete Renewal Modules 4 and 5 (Cycle 2)
- If you renewed your Cycle 2 two years ago, you must complete a Refresher Module 6 (Cycle 3)
