Readings for next weekend — Fifth Sunday of Easter

First reading: Acts 14:21-27; Second reading: Apocalypse 21:1-5; Gospel: John 13:31-35

Eastertide:

Just as Christmas day is the opening of the feast of Christmas, Easter Sunday is an overture of the coming season rather than the grand finale of Lent. Eastertide is fifty days stretching from the First Sunday of Easter until the Eighth Sunday (Pentecost). It's all Easter – one continuous celebration of resurrection. And just as we set aside one-seventh of our week the Sabbath day of rest, we set aside the season of Easter – approximately one-seventh of the year as consecrated time.

When Christ walks out of the tomb, his death is revealed to be the ark of salvation: the dead wood of the cross become a tree that bears fruit; and those who were dead to sin become a new creation in Christ.

So, having made it through the wilderness of Lent to the glorious promised land of Easter...what's next? H. Boone-Porter writes: "It's a strange irony that many people try to live faithfully during Lent to observe forty days of preparation, yet virtually abandon Eastertide after going to Church on Easer Day!" Everything we have done so far in the liturgical year has its meaning because of the resurrection of Christ. Rejoice! The Lord is risen.
