The EASTER TRIDUUM

Holy Thursday (April 17th) brings the end of Lent. That night we begin the Three Days that are the centre of our year. You are invited to make these three days different from all the days of the year.

We are invited to plan ahead (now) so that the whole time from Holy Thursday until the Easter Vigil is free of social engagements, work, entertainment and other distractions. We are asked to fast (and abstain from meat) on Good Friday and to maintain that fast through Holy Saturday in anticipation of the Easter Vigil.

On these three days, Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday we gather a number of times to hear some of the Church's most beautiful prayers and scriptures and we make some of our finest music. Please look closely at the parish schedule and make plans to take part in the various liturgies and opportunities for prayer.

This year, the Parish Youth Choir will lead the singing for the Holy Thursday Mass, the Parish choir will lead the Good Friday singing and the combined Youth and Filipino choirs along with the orchestra will lead the singing at the Easter Vigil.

We return our **Project Compassion** boxes and envelopes at the Holy Thursday Mass of the Lord's supper. They form an important part of the Offertory procession for this Mass – all are invited to bring forward their Project Compassion Boxes and envelopes at this time.
