Readings for next weekend — The Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed

First reading: Isaiah 25:6-9; Second reading: Romans 5:5-11; Gospel: Luke 7:11-17

The Year of MATTHEW

Beginning this Thursday evening (October 30th) and running for four weeks is a presentation on the Gospel of Saint Matthew which we will be read in the coming year at Sunday Masses. The format for the evening will be similar to that of Alpha: 7.00pm supper, 7.30pm video presentation followed by table discussion. We hope to be finished by 9.00pm.

The Gospel readings for Year A are dominated by an almost continuous reading of Matthew's Gospel. Why does the Church look back to this ancient text and read it thoroughly throughout the course of a Liturgical Year? There were many other Gospels written in the early years of the Church. But something about the Gospel of Matthew gave it authority in the early Church, and still addresses the Church's life and liturgy today. Can this text, which was written to address a Jewish-Christian Church in the '80s of the 1st century, still be a word of life for us in the 21st century?
