First reading: Deuteronomy 6:2-6; Second reading: Hebrews 7:23-28; Gospel: Mark 12:28-34

ADVENT (Part 1)

The season of Advent begins on Sunday 1st December. While the days and weeks of advent traditionally close our calendar year, they are, in fact, the very beginning of the liturgical year. The First Sunday of Advent is the Church's New Year's Day! Advent is also the preparatory period of the Cycle of Light (very appropriate in the Northern Hemisphere as the days get shorter). At the heart of this cycle we focus on God with us in the three comings of Christ: 1. Jesus' arrival in historic time as Mary's son. 2. Jesus' promised return at the end of time, and 3. Jesus' entrance into our own lives.

Here in Australia, in the southern hemisphere, we face a challenging set of circumstances that envelope our celebration of Advent. Lengthening days, summer weather, end of year BBQs and parties, endless shopping and general busy-ness. How do we prepare for the coming of the Lord in the midst of all these "other" things?
