As the governor of Jerusalem, Pilate understands kingship in a strictly political sense and does not want anyone to challenge his reign. Jesus confronts Pilate with a new vision of kingship, one that is not of this world but very much in this world. Jesus came to usher in a kingdom of truth and justice, of peace and prosperity. And we are called to help bring about this kingdom in our corner of the world. In our homes and communities, we are called to make the love of God known.

Today we come to the end of another liturgical year. But, before we jump too far into the freshness of Advent, let us pause and take stock of this past year of Christian living. Where did we encounter Christ? When did we act as Christ for another person? What do we need to change in the coming year?


