Readings for next weekend — The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ

First reading: Genesis 14:18-20; Second reading: 1 Corinthians 11:23-26; Gospel: Luke 9:11-17

Reintroduction of Holy Communion under both kinds (Practical matters)

Next weekend we will be reintroducing Holy Communion under both kinds at some of the weekend Masses, let us review some practical matters.

- 1. If you are feeling unwell, have a cold, or are running a temperature, then it would be advisable for you NOT to receive from the chalice. Common sense!
- 2. The Australian bishops have mandated an appropriate reverence before receiving Holy Communion the bow of the head as you bow your head before receiving the body of Christ, similarly you need to bow your head before receiving from the chalice. Similarly if you are not receiving from the chalice you will still need to make a reverence (bowing of the head) as you pass by the chalice Christ is present in both the bread AND the wine.
- 3. Having received and consumed the sacred host you then proceed to the minister holding the chalice, he or she will say to you "the blood of Christ" to which you will respond "Amen", the chalice will be passed to you for you to take a sip of the precious blood, you then hand the chalice back to the minister and make your way back to your place in church, joining in the singing of the communion song. You may NOT dunk the host in the wine. Jesus said take and drink...he didn't say take and dip!
