Evangelisation Point:

The Bible is not just a story of people who lived long ago and far away. The Bible is the living word for us today. We are in a period of new evangelisation for the Church. Many Catholics have simply stopped practising their faith, whether because of hectic lifestyles, disillusion with the scandals of the Church, or lack of faith. Still others never had an opportunity to learn the faith in their families. Jesus calls us, even if we have doubts, to share the stories of what God has done for us and to invite others to experience God's mercy and grace for themselves. We may never see the result; sometimes all we can do is plant a seed. We know, though that the Father, Son and Holy Spirit – this great Trinity – watches over all we encounter. What seeds are you planting right now that will help bring about the reign of God's Kingdom?
