Music and Liturgy

The treasury of sacred music is to be preserved and cultivated with great care. Choirs must be diligently developed, especially in cathedral churches. Bishops and other pastors of souls must do their best to ensure that whenever a liturgical action is to be accompanied by music and singing, the whole body of the faithful may be able to take that active part which is rightly theirs.
